
#### Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Friday, February 23rd to Wednesday, February 28th, 2024, among a sample of 1031 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Hamilton. The survey was conducted using automated telephone interviews (Smart IVR). Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Hamilton.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 3.1% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.




